ispace inc. (“ispace”) hereby announces that it has been resolved at the Board of Directors meeting today that ispace will enter into a HAKUTO-R Corporate Partnership Agreement with Kurita Water Industries Ltd. (“Kurita Water Industries”).

## 2. Overview of the Corporate Partner

ispace offers partnership programs in which it sells the rights to use ispace's activities as content, logo exposure on advertising media, and data usage rights as a package, and collaborates in technological and business development. Currently, we are offering partnership services for the period of Mission 1 and Mission 2 activities in the "HAKUTO-R" lunar exploration program by the commercial company. Partnership services are classified into Official Partner, Corporate Partner, Supporting Company, and Media Partner, depending on the service content and collaboration method. The main services of Corporate Partners include imprinting of the corporate logo on our lunar lander.

## 3. Background and future initiatives

Kurita Water Industries joined the HAKUTO-R program as a supporting company in 2023, and through its promotion to corporate partner, the two companies will build a stronger partnership and collaborate on future missions to equip lunar landers with water processing systems for use in space. For Mission 2, Kurita Water Industries provided ultrapure water, based on its water treatment technology, that will be delivered to the Moon as part of Takasago Thermal Engineering Corporation's payload. The water installed into Takasago's water electrolyzer equipment will serve to prove the water-splitting on the Moon. In the future, Kurita Water Industries expects to collaborate with ispace to carry its own payload on a future mission focused on its water treatment equipment.

## 5. Impact on financial results

As for our partnership services, contract payments are made in a lump sum or in multiple installments from the time of contract until the end of the HAKUTO-R program. In addition, sales are recorded by dividing the total sponsorship fee received from each partner into monthly installments from the time of signing the contract until the end of the program.

Since this contract was expected to be concluded during the current fiscal year and has already been incorporated into the consolidated earnings forecast for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2025, the impact on the earnings forecast is considered to be negligible.

The total contract amount for partnership services under the HAKUTO-R program, including this and the other corporate partner contract as well as one official partner contract disclosed on the same day, is 2,219 million yen.
