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### **Notice Regarding NASA's CP-12 Contract Between ispace-U.S. and Draper**

On July 9, 2026 (U.S. Mountain Time), the mutual end of the contract related to CLPS\* Task Order CP-12 entered into between the National Aeronautics and Space Administration ("NASA") and The Charles Stark Draper Laboratory, Inc. ("Draper") was effectuated. ispace, inc. ("ispace") hereby announces the following.

#### 1. Background

In July 2022, Draper was selected for Task Order CP-12 under NASA's CLPS program and entered into a contract with NASA in relation to CP-12. ispace technologies U.S., inc. ("ispace-U.S."), ispace's subsidiary, subsequently entered into a subcontract with Draper in relation to CP-12 (the "Subcontract") and has proceeded with the development of a lunar lander and preparations for its operation to provide lunar transportation services and other services under CP-12. Following the announcement of the mutual end of the contract between NASA and Draper, the Subcontract between ispace-U.S. and Draper is also expected to be terminated. When the termination to the Subcontract is finalized, ispace will promptly make a further announcement.
